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3.4.1 Outcomes of Extension activities in the neighborhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years.

Response:

Outreach is a crucial component of the academic plan at the college. It instills in the kids a sense of societal responsibility. It involves the students in community-based social service projects that address needs. In extension work, college officials performed a social survey under Unnat with student assistance.

India Abhiyan, The institution is intending to begin technology-based programmes for these villages, and the challenges are being explored. Because Hingoli is one of India's underdeveloped districts, the institution took part in the District Internship Programme run by the state government of Maharashtra and the government of India. Our college students did the socio-economic survey in many communities.

The sociology department performed a social survey to learn more about the socioeconomic status of nomadic tribe members, especially the "Vadar" caste. The institution consistently plans various extension initiatives because it recognizes the importance of social responsibility. In order to foster a sense of citizenship and national integration, the institution honors the birthdays and deaths of notable national figures. Through the following extension programmes, which our institute has arranged, we have fostered a sense of social responsibility in our pupils.

The organization held the Kerala Flood Relief Rally at Hatta. The people of Hatta graciously donated money, raising a fund to help the Kerala flood victims. On the college conducted the Sangli-Kolhapur Flood Relief Rally. The people of Hatta gave generously, rising fund to help those devastated by the storm.


The NSS hosts a residential camp for seven days in an adopted village. During the camp, volunteers from the NSS carry out various activities that address social issues. These activities include planting trees, raising awareness of environmental issues, women's empowerment, health check-ups, blood donation, veterinary care, and anti-superstition talks with practical examples. Tidiness Events are planned for both the Lord Ganesh celebration and the seven-day camp.

A Voter Awareness event has been organized at the college with the goal of educating voters about the electoral process, political parties, their platforms, and the backgrounds of the people running for office in order to assist them in casting their important ballots. All individuals in society, who have reached the age of eighteen, including college students, were instructed to register their names in the voter's list.

Raising public knowledge of the prevalence and transmission of HIV/AIDS is crucial to shielding the public from the pandemic. The organization plans AIDS awareness talks and demonstrations. The volunteers educated, informed, and communicated with the public on HIV/AIDS prevention.

The organization planned Covid awareness events and administered a Covid-related online test. Students and individuals were given masks and hand sanitizer by the NSS department.
