**Response:**

By making recommendations, creating plans, and setting up specific activities, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has made a substantial contribution to the institutionalization of quality assurance techniques and procedures. In India, the main goal of higher education is to advance research.

This practice was started by the IQAC to help staff and students develop a culture of research. In accordance with the college's IQAC guidelines, a research committee was established to take the lead on all research-related operations. The committee supports faculty members who want to do research, seek advice, and mentor other researchers. As a result, good no. of our college's permanent faculty members is now conducting research, while the other faculty members have Ph.D.s. The college extends congratulations to the Ph.D. recipients. Third-year B.A, B.Com, and B.Sc. students are also encouraged and motivated to finish their research projects by the committee. Academics are encouraged to publish high-caliber research articles and book chapters as well as deliver research papers at national and international seminars and conferences. As a result, our lecturers have published over good no. of research papers in the previous five years.

IQAC organizes conferences, webinars, workshops, and a faculty development programme. The university hosted a workshop on NAAC preparation sponsored by the IQAC during the 2018–2019 academic years. The institution hosted a one-day National E-Conference on Environment and Sustainable Development of Rural Areas: Issues, Problems, and Solutions during the 2019–2020 academic years. Teachers delivered their papers during this meeting. The same year, an intellectual property rights workshop was held at the institution. The university hosted a national webinar on the NAAC's revised assessment and accreditation framework with a focus on qualitative metrics during the 2020–21 academic years. The National Webinar on Migration and Literature was hosted by the institution that same year. It is constantly encouraged of the teachers to finish the RC, OC, STC, and FDP programmes.

In addition, IQAC implements several quality measures, such as consistently updating the AISHE's data. The college has started working on green auditing. The University conducts administrative and academic audits on a regular basis. Periodically, it also evaluates the effectiveness of the teaching and nonteaching staff.

Through an IQAC that is set up in accordance with standards, the institution analyses its teaching and learning process, operational structures and techniques, and learning outcomes at regular intervals. It then creates an action plan for the year that contains the recommendations that will be started and carried out.


The academic calendar, which is distributed to all teachers and students at the start of the school year, is prepared with assistance from IQAC by a committee led by the principal and made up of HODs.

The action plan is created by IQAC and is adhered to by the academic calendar. Every faculty member submits a semester-by-semester annual teaching plan, which is then carefully implemented throughout the academic year. It gathers syllabus completion reports from instructors and HODs at the conclusion of each semester and sends them to the principal. It is encouraged to use ICT for teaching and learning.

The college conducts guest lecturers to increase students' subject-matter expertise. The departments of English, Marathi, Hindi, Sociology, Geography, Economics, Political Science, Public Administration, Commerce, and Chemistry at the college have all given these lectures. The college invites renowned instructors from different universities to provide guest lectures. College students receive in-depth advice from knowledgeable instructors regarding the significance and difficulties of the subject. Additionally, they mentor pupils on the subject's components.

The learning outcomes are gathered by analysis of the examination results because of the review and operational procedures. Additionally, IQAC periodically confirms the learning objectives through departmental meetings and student feedback.
